

Planning Your Family Literacy Night Worksheet

1. **What is your theme, book or character?**

2. **What is your opening activity?**

This should be an activity that the student and parent can do together as

other people are arriving.

Examples: make visors for camp literacy night, make pirate flags for pirate

literacy night.

3. **Will your literacy event be whole school or grade specific?**

4. **What will your activities be?**

Whole group activities should include a snack and can include games, a dance and crafts.

While planning **grade specific activities** keep the age of the group in mind. Choose activities that involve the parents and are literacy based. Include a small snack at one station.

5. Whole group- What will your welcome/introduction be?

Examples: a craft like a small piñata for the Skippyjon Jones Literacy night or a fancy placemat for the Fancy Nancy Literacy night.

Grade specific event- What is your ultimate goal?

This is something that the students are working toward while moving through stations. Examples include: a clue at each station that helps solve

a mystery or a puzzle piece at each station that helps complete a riddle.

6. What will your closing event be?

Whole group event- a story read to the students based on the theme

Grade specific event- As a whole group, complete the ultimate goal
(solve the mystery, complete the riddle, etc.)
