Regents Predictive Reports for SLOs

WNYRIC's **Regents Predictive Reports** are designed to provide targets to inform the SLO development process. The reports are based on individual student performance on previous NYS assessments and on certain demographic factors that have been shown to correlate with assessment performance (Poverty, LEP, & SpEd status).

- Target scores are developed to present a score that 80% of the students in a population would be expected to meet or exceed. It is important to be clear on that point. The scores are NOT predictions of the score any individual student will achieve in a class. Most students will likely exceed that score.
- If a district elects to participate in this service, one person in a district will be provided access to the reports. The reports will not be visible to all people with access to the Data Warehouse.
- The cost is \$150 per building (BEDS code) at which a regents exam is administered. The cost is the same for all buildings, regardless of the number of regents courses offered in building and regardless of the level (MS or HS).
- There are two versions of the report.
 - One report is an extract showing all of the students in the buildings for which the service is purchased. It will be a spreadsheet that shows all the projections that can be made based on the students' past assessment history. This report will be ready as soon as scores for the NYS assessments used are available. We expect this to be in August
 - The second report will be at the teacher and section level. That will be dependent on the district having submitted Staff/Student/Course information to the WNYRIC Data Warehouse. We will provide a template that can be used to submit that information prior to the start of the normal data collection process for 2014-15.
